

## NOTICE OF ADOPTION OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 8 THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GRIMSBY

This notice has been reissued in accordance with the requirements of Ontario Regulation 149/20: Special Rules Relating to Declared Emergency. The last date for filing a notice of appeal has been revised in accordance with the requirements of this regulation.

**TAKE NOTICE** that on **April 6, 2020**, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Grimsby passed By-law 20-27 to adopt Official Plan Amendment No. 8 to the Town of Grimsby Official Plan, pursuant to Section 17 of the Planning Act, RSO., 1990.

**THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT** of Official Plan Amendment No. 8 is to amend Policy 3.6.3.1 of the Town of Grimsby Official Plan to permit retail uses less than 5,000 square metres and clinics at the property known municipally as **361 South Service Road**.

**OTHER RELATED PLANNING APPLICATIONS:** Zoning By-law Amendment, By-law No. 20-28 (File Number 26Z-16-1804), approved concurrently by Council on April 6, 2020. By-law No. 20-28 will take effect on the date of final approval of Official Plan Amendment No. 8

**PUBLIC COMMENTS**, as summarized in the Planning Staff Reports (<u>Report P.A. 19-45</u> and <u>Report P.A. 20-09</u>), were considered as part of the decision making process.

Official Plan Amendment No. 8 is exempt from approval by the Regional Municipality of Niagara.

## THE DECISION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GRIMSBY IS FINAL IF A NOTICE OF APPEAL IS NOT RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE THE LAST DAY FOR FILING A NOTICE OF APPEAL.

**IF YOU WISH TO APPEAL** to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal a copy of an appeal form is available from the LPAT website at <u>http://elto.gov.on.ca/</u>

Only individuals, corporations or public bodies may appeal a decision of the municipality or planning board to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the plan was adopted, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
