## Outdoor Dining Patio/Retail Sales Area Encroachment Program

Dine@Grimsby aims to provide more outdoor dining patio and retail sales areas to help some restaurants and retailers create a dynamic outdoor experience for patrons and still adhere to provincial guidelines during the summer/fall months.

## Fees waived for 2022 Outdoor Dining Patio/Retail Sales Area Encroachment Permits

As part of the Town's ongoing commitment to support economic recovery due to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Town of Grimsby Council has given the ability for Town staff to assess and issue an Outdoor Dining Patio Area Encroachment Permit to ease the process required to temporarily expand patios on some public and private properties.

Here's how to start your Outdoor Dining Patio/Retails Sales Area Application:

- Step 1 Contact the Town of Grimsby Dine@Grimsby Team to start the process by emailing Ruth Amio or Nolan Davis at <u>dine@grimsby.ca</u>
- Step 2 Review the Criteria for Outdoor Dining Patio/Retail Sales Area Encroachment.
- Step 3 If your dining establishment is on private property and you are a tenant (not a landlord or owner). You must provide a signed Consent from the Owner or Landlord and submit as part of your application.
- Step 4 Prepare a detailed site plan of the proposed Outdoor Dining Patio/Retail Sales Area Encroachment. Please refer to the Application Form and "Schedule A" for patio requirements and guidelines.
- Step 5 Complete the applicable Outdoor Dining Patio/Retail Sales Area Encroachment Form.
