



NOTICE OF PASSING OF AN INTERIM CONTROL BY-LAW THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GRIMSBY

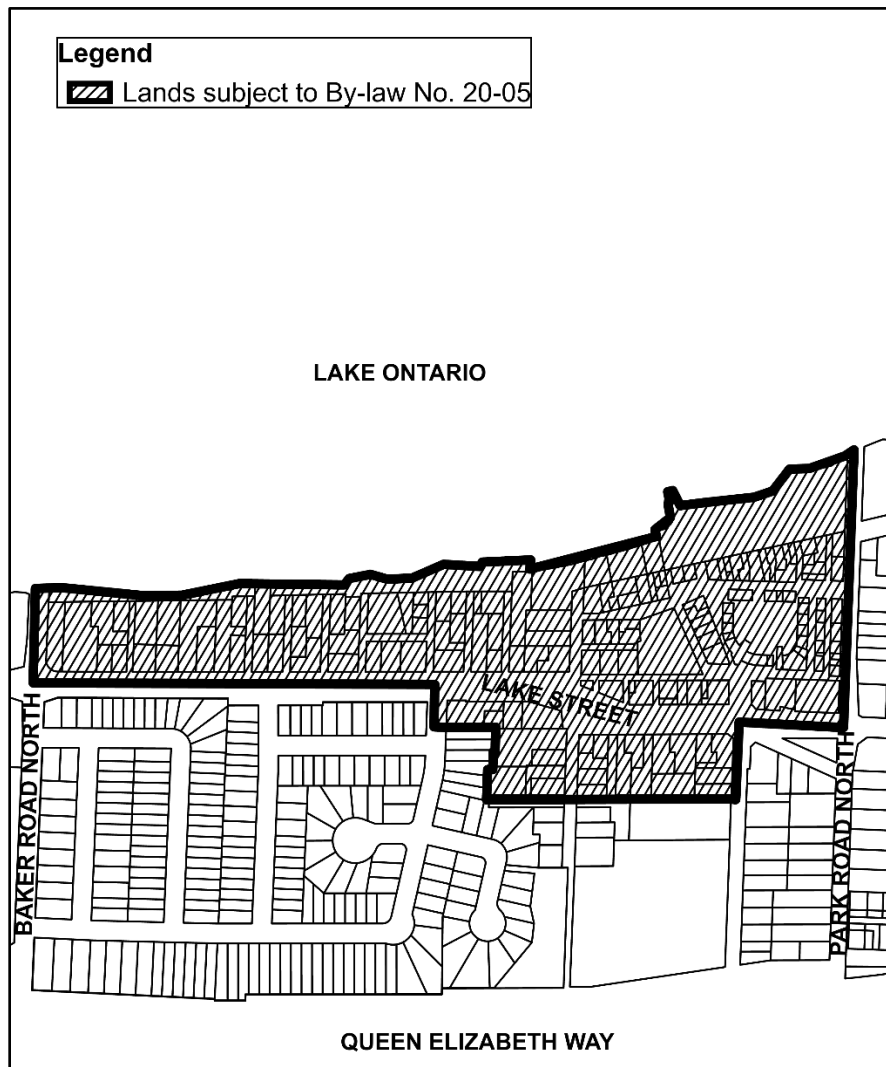
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TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Grimsby passed By-law No. 20-05 on the 3rd day of February 2020, under Section 38 of the Planning Act, R.S.O., 1990, as amended.

AND TAKE NOTICE that Interim Control By-law No. 20-05 was in effect for a period of one year from the date of passing, and has been extended by Council for an additional one-year period on the 6th day of April 2021 in accordance with Section 38 of the Planning Act, or repealed by Council at an earlier date.

THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT of Interim Control By-law No. 20-05 is to restrict the use of land, buildings or structures to existing uses and provide the Town with the opportunity to undertake a comprehensive land use planning study of the Grimsby Beach area.
