The Gadsby Shoe Factory is also located on the property and it was a place of innovation and production of shoes for Grimsby and all of Canada during the years of operation. There is also a physical connection between the factory and the small house, a wooden frame addition that extends between the structures. The Victory house is also in close proximity to the original The HG&B's rail line on Park Road. The rail line was a spur line of the primary line between Hamilton & Beamsville.
